



Over the years many people have made an impact on our basketball community. Below are just a few who we would like to honor this year at the Boardwalk Basketball Classic.

KAITLIN ANZELONE MEMORIAL – Kaitlin Anzelone was one of the most underrated female athletes ever to pass through Wildwood High School. A three-sport athlete, she was part of four South Jersey and three state championship girls' basketball teams, a league championship softball team and a girls soccer team that qualified for the state playoffs for the first time in program history. After graduating from Wildwood High School in 2003, Kaitlin went on to play all three sports during her freshman year at Rutgers-Camden University. Late in 2004, she was diagnosed with leukemia and passed away in July 2005 after an eight-month battle with the disease. Her accomplishments in the athletic arena, her personality away from it and her courageous battle with cancer are still remembered by the Wildwoods community today. The City of Wildwood and Wildwood High School renamed the soccer pitch at Maxwell Field to Kaitlin Anzelone Memorial Field in her memory approximately 10 years ago.

BIG AL NERENBERG MEMORIAL – "Big" Al Nerenberg was a local sports enthusiast and philanthropist who donated time and money to many youth and high school sports causes in the Wildwood area. He was a strong supporter and coach in the Greater Wildwood Little League. He also was an avid fan and statistician for the Wildwood Catholic High School basketball program and provided statistical work for high school basketball games broadcast on WCMC-AM radio. When he passed away in the early 1990s, Big Al was buried with a 1988 Wildwood Catholic South Jersey championship jacket at his side.

RAY MARTIN MEMORIAL – Ray Martin was an avid fan and supporter of high school sports all throughout Cape May County and was considered one of the fathers of bringing high school sports to the local airwaves. He provided play-by-play coverage of countless high school basketball games on WCMC-AM radio for more than 30 years, beginning in the late 1950s. After passing away in the early 1990s, his name was added to the holiday tournament. His family members regularly attend Boardwalk Basketball Classic games each year.

GEORGE BETZ MEMORIAL – George "Buzzy" Betz was a longtime teacher, athletic director and coach at Wildwood High School who oversaw the expansion of the school's athletic program in the 1970s, including the addition of many girls' sports programs at the school. Betz also served as beach director for the Wildwood Crest Beach Patrol. He passed away in the late 2000s.

BILL OSBORN MEMORIAL – Bill Osborn was a longtime supporter of and sports official for youth and high school sports in Cape May County. A resident of Wildwood Crest, Osborn was heavily involved in the Greater Wildwood Little League as a coach and umpire and also served as a coach and official in the many youth and high school sports leagues held out of the Crest Pier Recreation Center. He was also considered one of the most respected high school basketball officials of his generation. Osborn passed away in the early 2000s.

JAY CRAVEN MEMORIAL – Jay Craven was a history teacher and assistant boys' basketball coach at Wildwood High School in the 1960s. He also coached basketball at Lower Cape May Regional in the 1970s. He was considered one of the best tactical coaches of his time. Craven passed away in the mid 1970s after a short battle with cancer while in just his late 30s.

FRANK MCALARNEN MEMORIAL – Frank McAlarnen was the first boys' basketball coach at Wildwood Catholic High School, when the school opened in the late 1940s, and was considered one of the great innovators of the high school game during his time. He coached at the school through the late 1960s, posting an impressive career record of 285-117, a win total that still ranks all-time among Cape-Atlantic League boys basketball coaches. He led the Crusaders to two state Parochial C championships in 1958 and 1960 and guided the team to six straight South Jersey titles from 1955 through 1960 as well as four straight sectional crowns from 1963 through 1966. McAlarnen is a member of the Al Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame.

ERNIE TROIANO SR. MEMORIAL – Ernie Troiano Sr. was one of the most recognizable faces in the Wildwoods, whether it was at a local sporting event or many of the other countless community events in the area. He attended Wildwood High School before, like many of his classmates, he left school to join the military. He served with the Merchant Marines, serving in the mid to late 1940s. He was a longtime supporter of the Warrior 50 Booster Club, a fund-raising organization that serves the student-athletes at the school. Troiano was also a loyal and dedicated volunteer of the Boardwalk Basketball Classic since its inception. He volunteered his time at the Warrior 50/TKR Classic, a holiday tournament hosted by Wildwood High School prior to the inception of the BBC. He passed away in late 2009.

JOHN CARLSON MEMORIAL – John "Porky" Carlson was an athlete and graduate of Wildwood High School who eventually became one of the school's biggest supporters. He was at the forefront of many fund-raising efforts for the school and its athletic program, as well as various other activities in the Wildwoods community. Carlson was one of the founding members of the Warrior 50 Booster Club that serves the student-athletes at Wildwood High School. He passed away in the late 1990s.

ANDREW ALAMENO MEMORIAL – Andrew Alameno was a 1982 graduate of Wildwood Catholic and native of Wildwood Crest who served on the Wildwood Crest Beach Patrol. A successful businessman in New York City, Alameno passed away during the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center on Sept. 11, 2001. A small park in Wildwood Crest was recently renamed in his honor.

WILLIAM "CHICKIE" LUDMAN MEMORIAL – William "Chickie" Ludman was a standout athlete at Wildwood High School in the early 1970s, starring in basketball, football and baseball, earning Cape-Atlantic League all-star status in all three sports as a junior and senior. In basketball, he averaged in double figures in scoring during his sophomore through senior years and went to play college basketball at Augusta College (Ga.), where he set numerous single-season and career assist records. He later became a schoolteacher and successful head coach of the Middle Township High School boys' basketball team, going 52-22 over three seasons. Following his coaching stint at Middle, Ludman went on to become an assistant men's basketball coach at Richard Stockton State College (now Richard Stockton University) for a brief time until developing leukemia. He passed away in 1988 at the age of 35.

DAVE LEWIS MEMORIAL – Dave Lewis was one of the most well-liked personalities in the Cape-Atlantic League during his time as head boys' basketball coach at Oakcrest High School and his previous tenure as an assistant boys' basketball coach at Mainland Regional High School. Taking on his spirit and drive, Lewis's Falcon teams became of the more competitive programs in the CAL during his tenure, going 92-86 over seven seasons and winning one Cape-Atlantic American Conference title. Lewis also dedicated his professional life around the care of children and their families, working for children's Seashore House, the Voorhees Pediatric Facility, and the Weisman Children's Rehab Hospital. Lewis was also heavily involved in various charitable endeavors through the Central United Methodist Church in Linwood. He courageously battled cancer during his last couple of seasons as head coach at Oakcrest before passing away in June 2008. Lewis was a strong supporter of the Boardwalk Basketball Classic, bringing his teams to Wildwood each December.

BERNIE McCRACKEN MEMORIAL – Bernie McCracken was considered among the best coaches in Cape-Atlantic League history regardless of sport. After helping the Wildwood High School boys' basketball team to two South Jersey titles and a state championship as an assistant coach under Ray Lynch in the late 1950s and early 1960s, McCracken was the head coach at Wildwood for 16 seasons over two different stints. He compiled a 255-88 career record that included a state championship in 1964 and five South Jersey championships in 1963, 1964, 1965, 1972 and 1979. His teams also won six CAL titles during his tenure. McCracken and Ocean City's Dixie Howell are the only two boys' basketball coaches in CAL history with at least 250 career wins and less than 100 losses. His Wildwood teams won an incredible 18 times in 21 games against cross-town rival Wildwood Catholic, including the last 15 in row. Despite all of his success on the court, McCracken, a longtime mathematics teacher at Wildwood, was regarded by many as a better educator than basketball coach. McCracken passed away in Lakeland, Fla., in February 2013.

GENNY FARNAN MEMORIAL – Genny Farnan was a standout girls basketball player at Wildwood Catholic High School in the mid 2000s who is ranked among the top 15 all-time in program history in career scoring with 1,025 points. A 5-6 shooting guard, Farnan was a four-year varsity player who competed for teams that improved their win totals in each of her four seasons with the Crusaders, culminating with a 17-7 campaign during her senior year in 2004-05. Farnan, whose father, Paul, is a retired South Jersey basketball official, briefly attended Drexel University before graduating from Rowan University. Farnan was diagnosed with glioblastoma, an aggressive form of brain cancer and passed away at the young age of 29 in March 2016. A nonprofit named in her memory, NextGen30, provides financial assistance for graduating high school seniors from Cape May County who are attending college and also promotes good works and acts of kindness in the Cape May County community.

JOHN PIERANTOZZI MEMORIAL – John Pierantozzi was one of the most well-known names in South Jersey high school sports. A longtime educator at Vineland High School, Pierantozzi was a successful football, track, basketball, and golf coach for the Fighting Clan in the 1970s and 1980s. He also coached basketball in the 1970s at Sacred Heart High School. He was also involved in Vineland High School football as a broadcaster for a cable television station in the Vineland area. Pierantozzi may be best known, however, as one of the top high school basketball officials in the state of New Jersey. He worked many of the important games throughout the Cape-Atlantic League area and officiated countless state playoff contests, including many sectional and state championship games, over the course of his long and distinguished career. Pierantozzi was a certified basketball official for more than 50 years and served a long tenure as president of South Jersey Board 196. He was also an evaluator of officials across the state and served as an instructor for Board 196's cadet program for new officials. Pierantozzi was a major contributor to and supporter of the Boardwalk Basketball Classic since its inception, once serving as the BBC committee's liaison with the tournament's basketball officials. Pierantozzi passed away in August 2021 at the age of 80.

FRAN ST. JOHN – Fran St. John is an icon of basketball both at Wildwood Catholic and throughout the entire Cape-Atlantic League. Most recently an assistant coach with the Crusader girls' team before retiring following the 2022-23 season, St. John coached for 56 seasons overall at the North Wildwood School. He led the Crusader boys for 23 seasons over two different stints, compiling a 306-283 record in a head coaching career that began in the late 1960s. His 1988 team won the South Jersey Non-Public B championship. He later became the head girls coach at Wildwood Catholic for 11 seasons, winning another 148 games against 128 losses before stepping down after the 2010-11 season. He was the first basketball coach in CAL history to win at least 100 games each as a boys and girls basketball coach. A member of the South Jersey Basketball Hall of Fame, St. John is one of the most respected coaches in CAL history. He was a popular, effective, and respected guidance counselor at Margaret Mace Elementary School before his retirement. St. John was a standout player at WCHS helping the Crusaders with the South Jersey title and reach the state Parochial C title game in 1956. The basketball floor at Wildwood Catholic Academy was recently named in his honor.

2024 BOARDWALK BASKETBALL CLASSIC

MICHELLE TARBOTTON-RUCCI – Michelle Tarbotton-Rucci is one of the all-time great basketball players in the history of Wildwood Catholic High School. A 1982 graduate of the school, Tarbotton-Rucci was the second female basketball player in school history to score 1,000 points, finishing her career with 1,123. She was also a standout field hockey and softball player at WCHS. Tarbotton-Rucci went on to enjoy a productive four-year career at Cabrini College in both field hockey and basketball, serving as a team captain for the Cavalier basketball team as a senior. Upon graduation, she became a schoolteacher at Margaret Mace Elementary in North Wildwood, where she also coached both the boys and girls' basketball teams and served approximately 3 ½ decades as a teacher before her retirement. She also coached field hockey at Wildwood Catholic in the early to mid 1990s. Tarbotton-Rucci currently resides in North Wildwood with her family. Michelle has been fighting a courageous battle against multiple sclerosis since being diagnosed with the disease approximately 25 years ago.

TOM WILLIAMS – Tom Williams is a well-known, award-winning South Jersey media member who has been a strong supporter of regional and Cape-Atlantic League area high school sports through his writing for the Gazette and Current newspapers of Catamaran Media, his broadcasting work for various radio stations in the Jersey shore area, his contributions to the CoastSportsToday.com and OceanCitySports.com websites, and his many basketball showcase events such as the Ocean City PBA Tipoff Classic and the Girls Basketball Shootout. He has also been a meticulous statistician for the football and boys' basketball teams at Ocean City High School and has also served in that role for the Cape-Atlantic League playoff tournament and the NJSIAA state championship games. Williams was inducted into the Al Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame in 2012. The press box at Ocean City's Carey Stadium was recently named in his honor.

TOM JORGENSON MEMORIAL – Tom Jorgenson is a legendary name in youth and high school sports in the Wildwoods. He coached numerous youth basketball and baseball teams over the years and is regarded as an icon in the Greater Wildwood Little League. Jorgenson, was a strong supporter of local high school sports and attended numerous high school basketball games each season, particularly at Wildwood High. During his early years living in New York City, he was a boxer (Staten Island Boys Champ) and a semi-pro baseball and football player. Jorgenson once earned a tryout with Major League Baseball's New York Giants and, as an accomplished chess player, competed against renowned world chess champion Bobby Fisher. He passed away at the age of 95 in February 2015.

JACK BUCHANAN MEMORIAL – Jack Buchanan was always one to be involved in the welfare of the community kids. From 1960 through 2003, he worked at the Wildwood Crest Pier Recreation Center, where he coached several teams and ran numerous leagues. He coached the Island Varsity Basketball Team, known as the Green Hornets, to many Cape May County boys' league championships. During the 1960s, Jack coached Wilson TV of the Greater Wildwood Little League. When not coaching basketball and baseball, he coached the Greater Wildwood Football League Red Raiders and ran the Saturday morning Police League for grade school kids and the adult men's basketball leagues at night. One of Buchanan's biggest accomplishments was the organization of the Crest Men's Summer League, which was one of the premier summer leagues in South Jersey. Some of the most entertaining games were played at the old outdoor court at which many great players honed their skills. Buchanan was always looking to help people on and off the court. He split his time between Florida and Wisconsin in his later years and still played golf and softball and was an avid swimmer all the way up to his death at age 89. Buchanan was one of the most influential people in the lives of most boys and girls who came in contact with him. His mild-mannered approach had a tremendous effect on all.

DOUG DEWEESE MEMORIAL - A native of Schenectady, N.Y., Douglas S. DeWeese was a science teacher and multi-sport coach at Wildwood High School from 1949 through 1960. He guided the Warrior boys' basketball team to three Cape-Atlantic League titles, three South Jersey championships and an appearance in the 1957 state championship game during his tenure. DeWeese also coached football, baseball and track and served as president of the CAL during his 11 years at Wildwood. He then taught and coached football at Delsea Regional High School for one year before becoming the athletic director and a health and physical education teacher at Lower Cape May Regional High School in 1962. He worked at Lower Cape May until his death in 1981. DeWeese served as a beach lifeguard in the summer months and was the captain of the North Wildwood Beach Patrol for three years. He became well known for leading calisthenics exercises for hundreds of residents and visitors on the Lincoln Avenue beach in Wildwood. He also managed numerous hotels and motels in Wildwood and Cape May. Prior to his career in education, DeWeese played football, basketball, and lacrosse at Springfield College in Massachusetts. Upon graduation, he served in the United States Navy as a pilot for 3 ½ years. One of his duties was transporting wounded soldiers. DeWeese was inducted into the New Jersey Scholastic Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 1974.

LOU BASELICE MEMORIAL – Lou Baselice was a longtime supporter of youth and high school athletics, particularly basketball, in the Wildwoods and throughout Cape May County. Lou worked as a commercial printer and was also a longtime respected high school basketball official in the Philadelphia area for many years before moving to the Wildwoods in the 1990s. He continued his officiating work in grammar school and recreation leagues throughout Cape May County for a few years after his arrival. He also mentored many area youth players through his work in the recreation departments in both Wildwood Crest and North Wildwood and was often referred to as "Mr. Lou" by the many children who crossed his path. Lou was an avid fan of high school basketball in Cape May County. He attended dozens of games of each season, often sitting in the front row and receiving greetings from the many players and coaches who knew him before and after games. A fine athlete himself in his day, Lou once signed a minor league baseball contract and briefly played in the New York Giants organization in the early 1950s. Lou passed away in September 2019 at age 88 after a lengthy illness.

ANTHONY "TONY" CALOGERO MEMORIAL – Anthony "Tony" Calogero was a lifelong resident of the Wildwoods. He was a Speech Therapist for 32 years in the Wildwood School District. He was also a Junior High Boys Basketball Coach as well as Head Girls Varsity Softball Coach. Calogero was a fixture at many Wildwood High School sporting events, serving as site manager, and also regularly attended games at the Boardwalk Basketball Classic. Tony, who had no children of his own, made helping deserving students a priority during his teaching career. He passed away in July of 2018, and is sorely missed by all who knew him.

GEORGE HOLDEN SR. MEMORIAL – George Holden is considered as one of the most iconic coaches in the history of Cape-Atlantic League boys' basketball. He enjoyed two coaching stints at Lower Cape May Regional High School (1969-72 and 1976-85), leading the program to Cape-Atlantic League titles in 1972 and 1985. He finished his career, which also included a brief stint as the head boys' basketball coach at Haddon Heights, with a record of 216-130. Holden is the patriarch of one of the most successful basketball families in CAL history. His sons, Pat and Scott, were dynamic players at Lower Cape May and Wildwood Catholic, respectively, and both went on to coach the boys' team at Lower Cape May. Holden's grandchildren, Lauren and Pat, are the all-time leading scorers in Lower Cape May girls' and boys' basketball history, respectively, and each went on to play college basketball. For the duration of Lauren's and Pat's careers, Mr. Holden could regularly be seen watching from the front row of the stands while keeping meticulous statistics of each game. Another of his grandchildren was the starting goalkeeper for the field hockey team at Division I University of Virginia. And yet another granddaughter, Lindsay, currently plays college basketball at Division III Neumann University. Mr. Holden passed away in July 2018 at age 84 after a long illness.

AL "THE GENERAL" MELINI MEMORIAL - AI "The General" Melini was a former Social Studies Teacher in the Vineland School District for 30 years. He was also a dedicated volunteer coach for the Wildwood High School girls' basketball team for 21 years and was a very positive influence on the student athletes. He was well known for his fondness for former college basketball coach Bobby Knight, which earned AI the nickname, "General." AI was also an avid golfer who was a longtime employee at Avalon Golf Club after his retirement from teaching. His love for the game of basketball and his keen sense of humor are sorely missed.

DAVE TROIANO – Dave Troiano is a founding member of the Boardwalk Basketball Classic committee and has worked tirelessly to promote the tournament and its mission. He was previously a schoolteacher and an incredibly successful girls' basketball coach at Wildwood High School. He led the Lady Warrior program to four state championships, nine South Jersey titles and more than a dozen conference or division titles in both the Cape-Atlantic League and the Tri-County Conference. He posted a 682-326 career record, his win total the best among high school girls basketball coaches in South Jersey history at the time of his retirement. Dave is a member of the Al Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame. He also coached softball at Wildwood High School, winning a Cape-Atlantic League championship in the early 2000s. Dave and his wife, Carol, reside in Cape May Court House.

VINCE TROMBETTA – Vince Trombetta is a longtime basketball official in both the Philadelphia and Jersey Shore areas. He is a retired schoolteacher who enjoyed a long career as a football coach and girls basketball coach at various schools in the Philadelphia Public League. Vince is best known for his 60-plus-year career as a basketball official from youth leagues all the way to the Division I college level. Vince can still be spotted officiating in the various summer basketball leagues in the Wildwoods and riding his bicycle on the Wildwoods Boardwalk during the warm-weather months. One of the most well-known figures in basketball in the Delaware Valley, Vince has long been considered a great ambassador of the game. He also has officiated high school softball, track, and cross country. Previously a longtime resident of South Philadelphia who spent his summers at the Jersey Shore, Vince is now a full-time resident of Wildwood who spends his winter evenings attending many high school basketball games in the area.

HOWARD "PUTT" PALMER MEMORIAL – Putt Palmer was a lifelong resident of the Wildwoods who was a strong supporter of youth and high school sports on the island. He was employed by a local utility company for much of his working career, but later also worked at the Wildwoods Convention Center, where he was involved in the setup and breakdown of the facility for the Boardwalk Basketball Classic. Putt was a tremendous supporter of Wildwood High School, from which he graduated, attending many of the school's sporting events each year. He was known across the community as the No. 1 fan of the Wildwood High School girls' basketball team. Putt and his wife often went several straight seasons without missing a home or away game. He even occasionally served as a volunteer coach at Lady Warrior practices. Putt was a three-sport athlete in high school and played basketball well into adulthood, often seen competing in pickup games on the Eighth Avenue courts in North Wildwood. He also served as a youth football coach for the North Wildwood Spitfires. Putt passed away in March 2019 at the age of 85.

TOM FERACO – Tom Feraco was one of South Jersey's most successful high school boys' basketball coaches. He led the program at Middle Township High School for a total of 37 seasons over two different stints as head coach. Feraco guided Middle to nine South Jersey championships and three state titles (1993, 1994 and 2002), while directing the program to 20-win seasons on 21 different occasions and numerous divisions and/ or conference championships in the Cape-Atlantic League. Feraco ranks second in CAL boys' basketball history in head coaching victories, going 733-270 for his career. Feraco was a standout athlete at Wildwood Catholic High School, where he scored more than 1,000 points as a basketball player and was also an individual state champion in cross country. Today, Feraco is a successful local businessman who helps run local franchises of a national liquor retail chain.

2024 BOARDWALK BASKETBALL CLASSIC

TOM MITCHELL MEMORIAL – Tom Mitchell was a well-known member of the Wildwoods community who dedicated years of service in the military, the City of Wildwood Police Department, the high school basketball program at Wildwood High School and through a longtime tenure on the Boardwalk Basketball Classic organizing committee. He was an assistant girls' basketball coach at Wildwood High School from the late 1990s into the mid 2010s, helping head coach Dave Troiano guide the program to three state championships and six South Jersey titles during that span. A member of the United States Army with service in Vietnam, Mitchell was a longtime member of the City of Wildwood Police Department, where he rose to the rank of captain before his retirement, and served as a volunteer firefighter in the city. He also served as an official in basketball and track and field. Mitchell was a fine athlete in his day, known as a sharpshooter in basketball who continued to play the game at local playgrounds and rec centers into his 60s. He lettered in basketball, football and track and field as a student-athlete at Wildwood High School. Mr. Mitchell passed away at age 80 in late August 2023.

JIM LEAHY MEMORIAL – Jim Leahy was the captain and leading scorer of the 1981 South Jersey champion Wildwood Catholic boys basketball team. At the time of his graduation, he was the program's all-time leading scorer with 1,345 career points. Leahy was one of four from his immediate family to score more than 1,000 points in high school, along with his father, Jim, and brothers Dan and John. John is currently a very successful girls basketball coach at Middle Township High School. Jim Leahy was married with two children and had been running a chain of Catholic thrift stores in Texas when he passed away at the age of just 56 in early 2019 after a three-year battle with cancer.

MARY THERESA VEY MEMORIAL – Mary Theresa "M.T." Vey was an extremely influential member of the Wildwood Catholic High School/Academy community, serving as cheerleading coach for more than 20 years and twice helping spearhead efforts to save the school from closing. After a nearly 30-year career in finance, M.T. earned a master's degree in church management from Villanova University in 2017 and went on to become an administrative assistant for the parish of Notre Dame de la Mer in Wildwood, for which she also served as a lector and eucharistic minister. A longtime member of the Boardwalk Basketball Classic organizing committee who passed away at age 67 in late May after a long battle with cancer, M.T. is survived by Michael, her husband of 43 years; four children; one grandchild; and many other family members.

ALBERT "BUDDY" E. TARBOTTON III MEMORIAL – Buddy Tarbotton was a charter member of the Boardwalk Basketball Classic's organizing committee, serving from the tournament's inception in 1998 before stepping down after the 2022 tournament. A longtime local broadcaster, Tarbotton called high school football and basketball games for nearly 30 years for 98.7 The Coast radio and the CapeAtlanticLive.com website. He was also a part-time sportswriter for the Cape May County Gazette and Wildwood Leader from the 1980s into the 2000s. In addition, Tarbotton served as an assistant boys basketball coach at Wildwood Catholic, his alma mater, in the 1980s and 1990s and later coached basketball at Margaret Mace Elementary and for local AAU basketball teams. A former longtime director of recreation in his hometown of North Wildwood, Tarbotton passed away at age 63 this past summer after a long battle with numerous health problems.

DAVID "DAVE" S. DEWEESE – After some time as an assistant coach as well as a grammar school coach in Wildwood Crest, Dave DeWeese was the head boys basketball coach at Wildwood Catholic Academy for nearly 20 seasons before stepping aside after the 2020-2021 season. He led the program to its best run of success, producing three straight Cape-Atlantic League playoff tournament championships (2020 through 2022) and four overall, three South Jersey title game appearances and the South Jersey Non-Public B championship in 2020. He guided the Crusaders to 13 combined division and/or conference titles within the CAL and produced a career record of 324-176. He also helped a number of his players earn the opportunity to compete at the college level, including quite a few who reached the Division I level. A successful attorney in the Wildwoods area, DeWeese has been a longtime member of the Boardwalk Basketball Classic's organizing committee.

The Boardwalk Basketball Classic mourns the loss of Buddy Tarbotton and Mary Theresa "M.T." Vey, who each passed away earlier this year after lengthy illnesses.

Buddy and M.T. were well known members of and contributors to the Wildwoods community and longtime members of the Boardwalk Basketball Classic's organizing committee.

Buddy was a former basketball coach and recreation director who became a major contributor to local high school basketball through his nearly 30 years of broadcasting for local radio and live video streams and writing for local newspapers.

M.T. enjoyed a long career in finance while also coaching the cheerleading team at Wildwood Catholic Academy for more than two decades. She also served as an administrative assistant at Notre Dame de la Mer parish, which serves the Wildwoods.

Buddy and M.T. also each further dedicated themselves to the community by serving as longtime lectors and eucharistic ministers during church services for Notre Dame de la Mer parish.

The Boardwalk Basketball Classic celebrates the contributions Buddy and M.T. made to not only the tournament but also to the community at large. They are sorely missed by all. Our thoughts and prayers go out to Buddy and M.T., as well as their families and friends.
